Year Groups: 4/5 – Hawks & Buzzards

Term/weeks: Autumn 1

As readers...

This term, we will be focusing on the book 'A Roman Story' for our whole class reading session. This will also link in with our writing and our topic, The Romans. At the end of each school day, the children will be read to from our class story.

Please support your child's progress by reading regularly with your child at home.

As writers...

In English, the children will be listening to Aesop's fables, exploring settings, characters, descriptive language and of course the moral within each story. Our grammar focus this term will be the correct use of capital letters, full stops, question marks, exclamation marks and commas within sentences. Year 5 children will also be extending their understanding of apostrophes for contractions and possession.

As mathematicians...

We will be focusing on number and place value, including:

- Representing numbers
- Counting (in varied steps, including backwards beyond zero)
- Comparing and ordering numbers
- Rounding numbers
- Representing, ordering and comparing negative numbers.

We will also be revisiting many key areas from the previous year group, and spending time reacquainting ourselves with number facts, particularly the times tables and number bonds to 10 and 100.

Religion Education

We will be learning about Sikhism and exploring the key question: 'How far would a Sikh go for their religion?'

As members of our community (PSHE):

'Being me in my World' - we will discuss how we are valued at school, how we are successful as individuals and the importance of school rules.

As linguists:

We will be revising greetings, recognising and using letters of the alphabet and completing comprehension activities to consolidate all previous learning. We will then move on to translating simple texts of different genres.
