As readers...

We will be reading traditional stories and 'twisted' traditional stories as a class. Reading lessons will focus on a range of different reading skills, including: decoding, skimming and scanning as well as other comprehension skills.

Please continue to read regularly at home – aim for at least 3 times each week ©

As writers...

After reading and analysing traditional tales and some examples of 'twisted' traditional tales, we will be writing our own versions.

We will be checking our developing our sentences, looking at conjunctions, prepositions and adverbs. We will also be using and punctuating fronted adverbials in our writing.

As linguists...

In French we will be naming classroom items; using colours and numbers to build simple sentences; using problem-solving skills to translate a spoken and written text

As mathematicians...

We will focus on fractions initially – recognising, finding and comparing fractions before moving on to mass, capacity and temperature.

We will continue to work on our KIRFs targets. The class KIRFs focus will be: Multiplication and division facts for the 4x tables in Puffins and multiplication and division facts for the 8x tables in Nightingales.

'Abstract shape and space'

This term we focussing on transforming 2D card shapes into three-dimensional structures and sculptures. We will explore abstract shapes and space, develop skills in constructing 3D objects, and understand the difference between 2D and 3D art.

We will be looking at the artwork of: Ruth Asawa and Anthony Caro.

we will be looking at 'Being Me in My World' and the year ahead, including being a global citizen.
