Street Tag

Street Tag is a free, interactive smart phone app that promotes community wide participation in physical activities such as walking, cycling and running, turning the world around you into a virtual playground, where points are gained by being physically active and collecting virtual tags. The app can be used to improve mental and physical wellbeing through movement and competition, whilst allowing exploration of open spaces and points of interest within the local community.

Wiltshire Council are promoting Street Tag across all schools in the county. We will be in touch again soon, to explain a bit more about how you can get involved and how this will link to school.
