

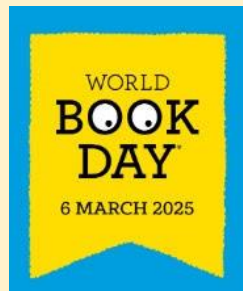


REDLAND PRIMARY SCHOOL NEWSLETTER 7.3.25

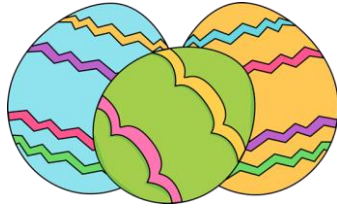
FORS NEWS
